



- 1. Set the printer page to A4.
- 2. 4 Black Index Points on 4 corners of sheet should be printed Solid & Dark in Black color.
- 3. If the index points are not printed properly, they will not be scanned properly, and this will give trouble while reading. Please make sure sheets are clean and there is no black dust or line over the bubbles or near the index points.



- 4. Keep the scanner's sheet holding brackets properly fit to avoid unnecessary tilting of sheet.
- 5. Keep the scanning area wide enough so that the corner 4 index points are properly scanned and there is sufficient white space outside them.
- 6. Do NOT increase brightness or contrast unless guided. Scan at default settings.



- 7. **Scan at 100 dpi.** Sheets with Barcode/ OCR/ ICR/ Image are scanned at 150-200 dpi.
- 8. Save as JPG or TIFF. DO NOT save as DOC/PDF.



After correct Printing, filling & Scanning, the sheet image should look like this:
